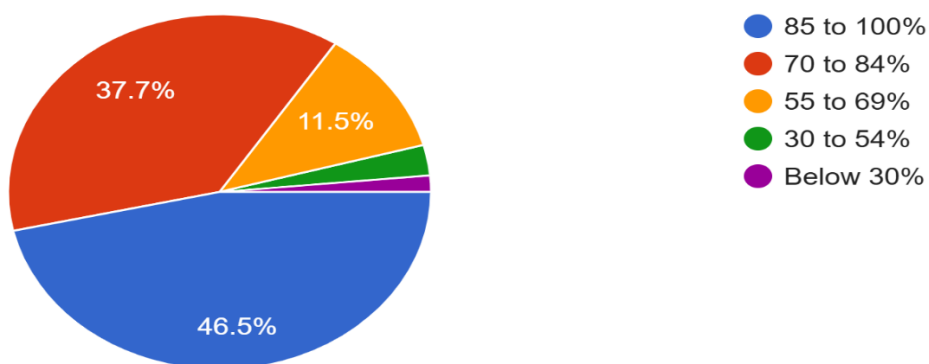
REPORT OF STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY (2025-26)

Dr. Khatri Mahavidyalaya is an institution committed to continuous improvement through an inherent closed-loop system that regularly evaluates its functioning and implements corrective measures based on feedback and surveys. The Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is one of the important components of this quality-assurance mechanism. The survey primarily incorporates the questionnaire recommended by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). In addition to assessing various aspects of the teaching-learning and evaluation process, the survey also covers institutional infrastructure, student welfare facilities, and other support services.

A total of 469 students participated in the survey, representing 55.57% of the student population. The survey was systematically organized to obtain students' perceptions and feedback regarding the academic and non-academic facilities and services provided by the institution. 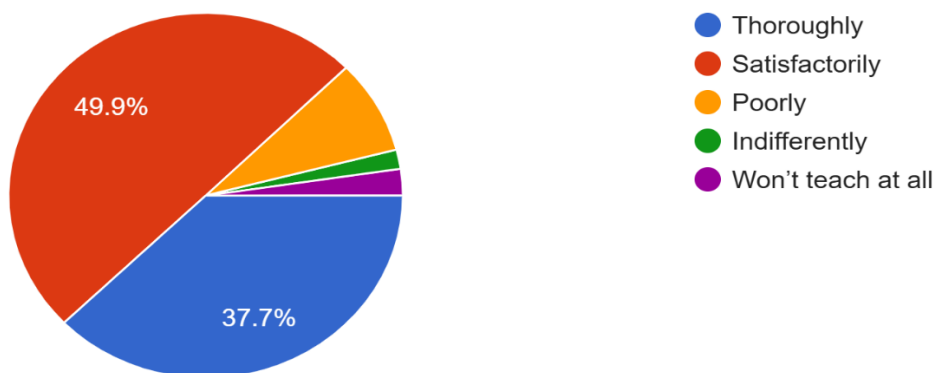
How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

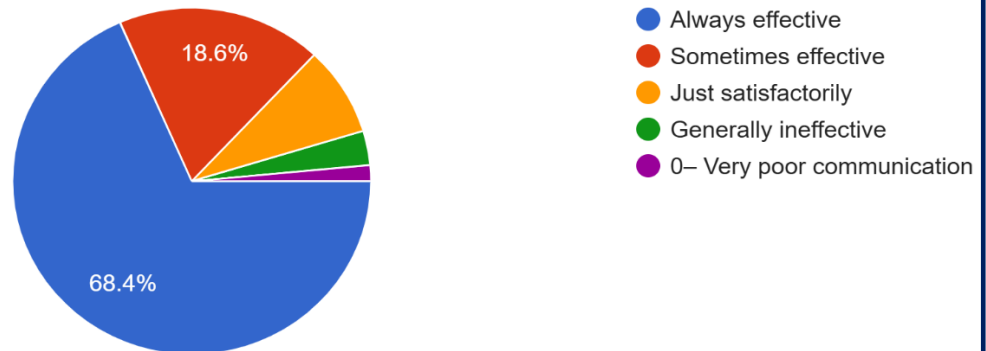
How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

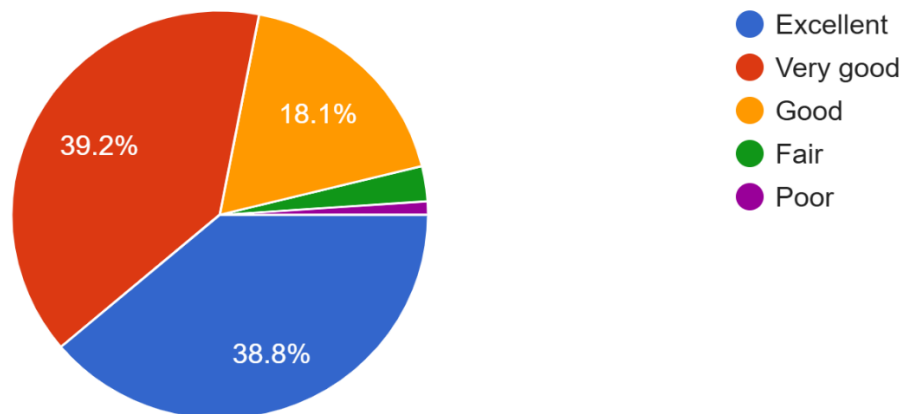
How well were the teachers able to communicate?

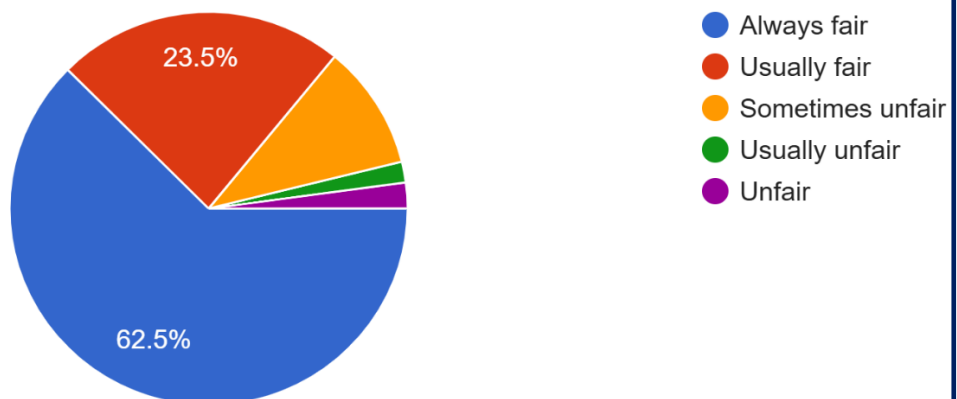
The teacher's approach to teaching is...

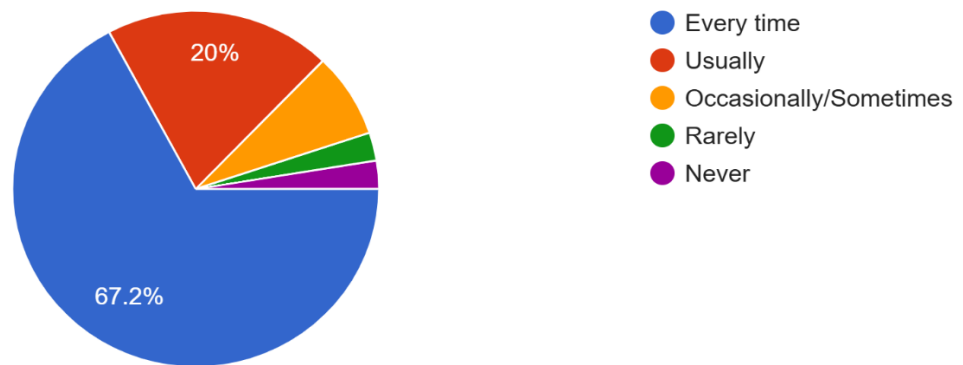
Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

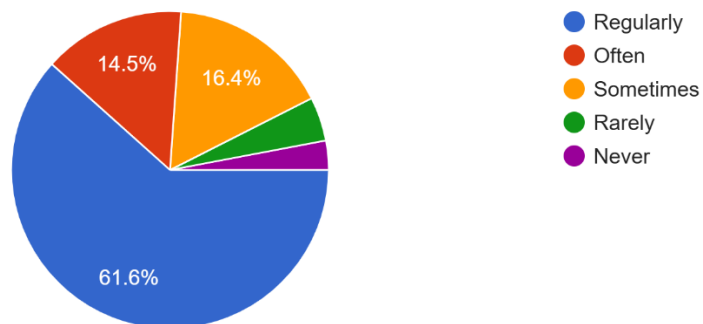
Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

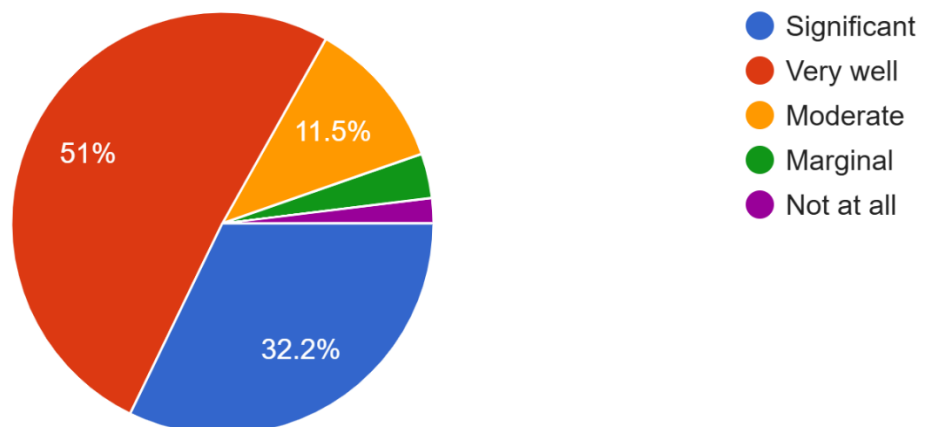

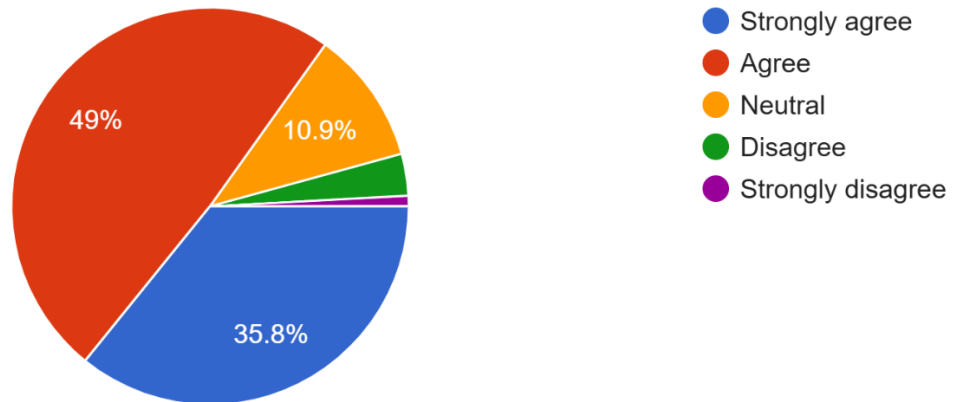
The teaching and mentoring process in your institution is _____

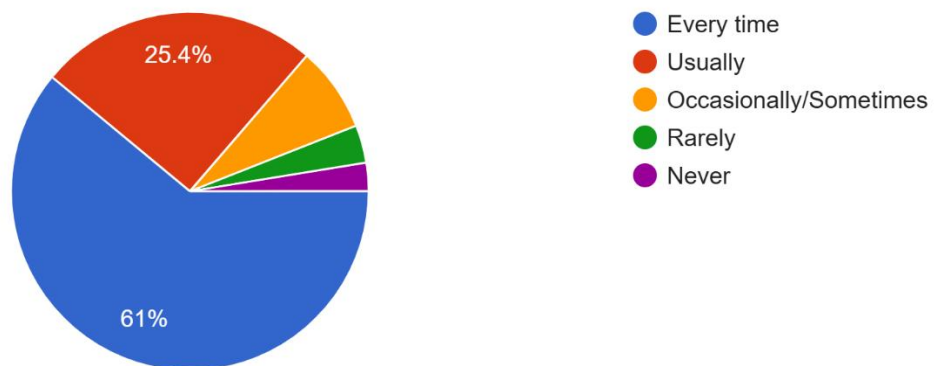
The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

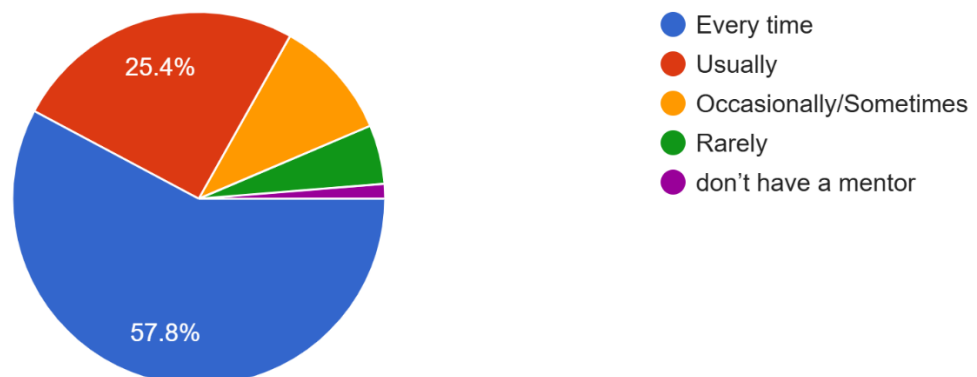
Teachers inform you about your expected course outcomes and programme outcomes.

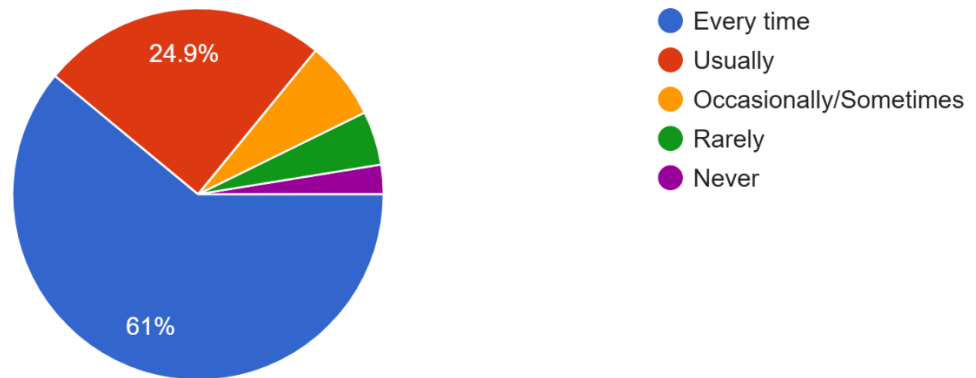
Your mentor takes a necessary follow-up

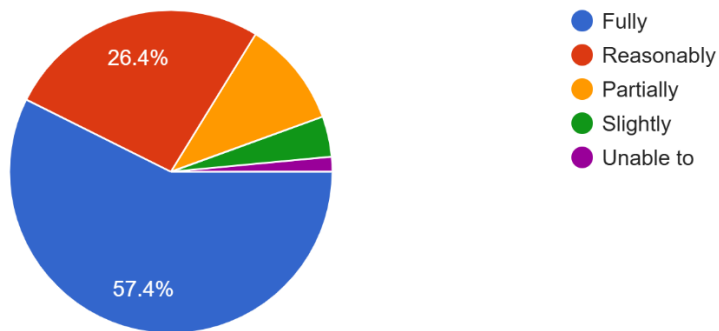
The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

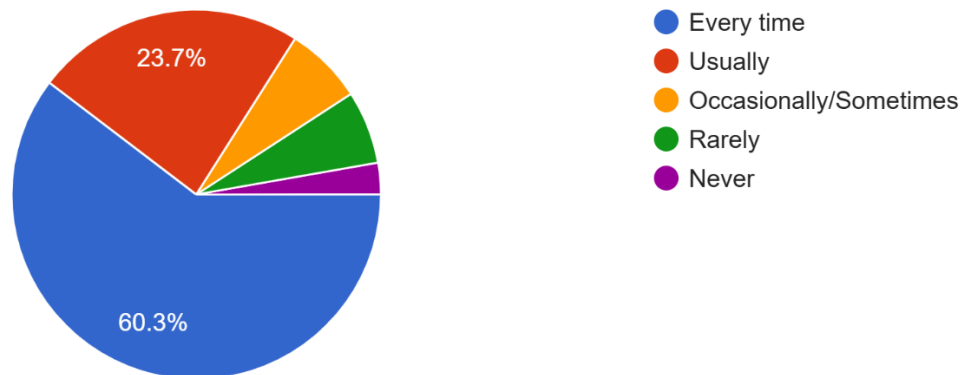

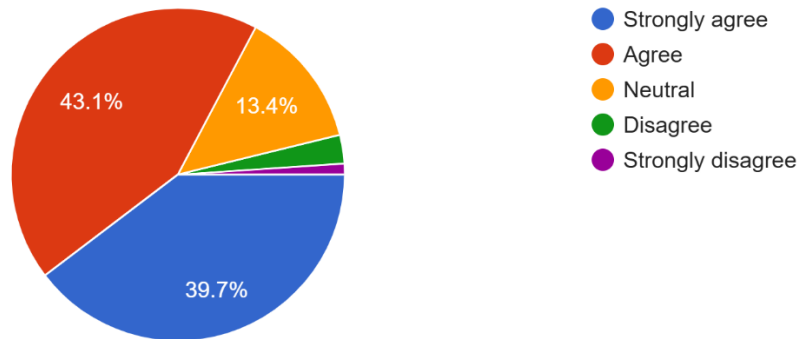

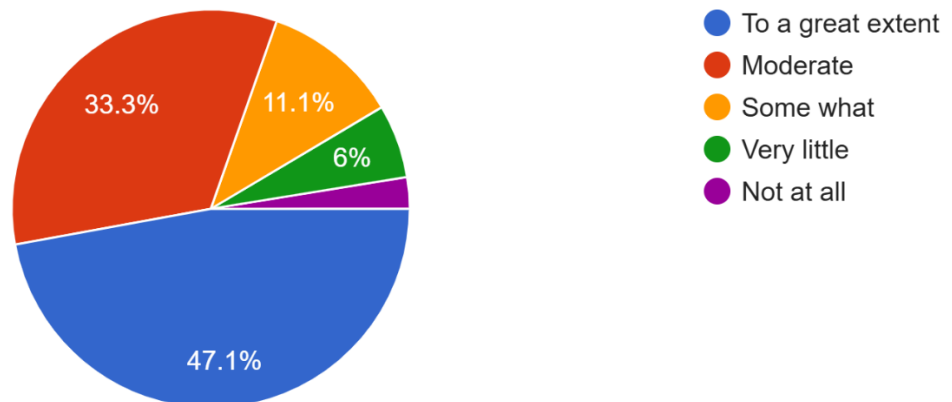

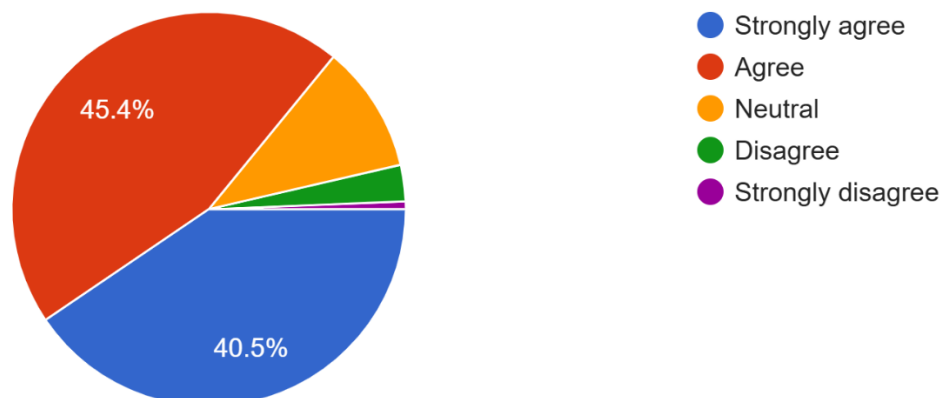

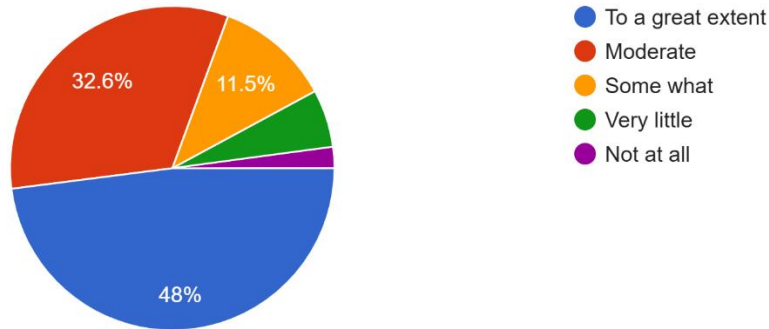

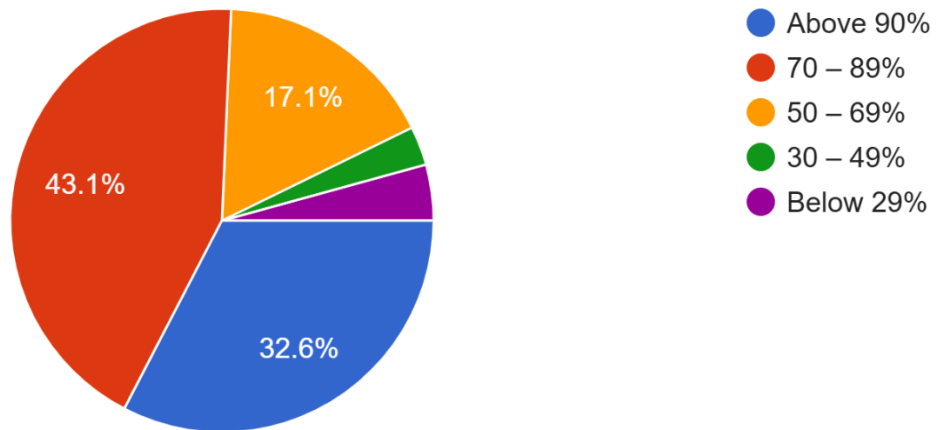
